## **CHAPTER 264**, Laws of 1973

AN ACT to amend 158.01 (1) (a) and (c); and to create 158.01 (1) (e) of the statutes, relating to services performed by barbers.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 158.01 (1) (a) and (c) of the statutes are amended to read:

158.01 (1) (a) Shaving, trimming the beard, or cutting or styling the hair;

(c) Singeing, shampooing, arranging, <u>curling</u>, <u>waving</u>, dressing, <u>hair relaxing</u> or dyeing of the hair, or applying hair tonics;

SECTION 2. 158.01 (1) (e) of the statutes is created to read:

158.01 (1) (e) Styling or cutting hair pieces or wigs.
