## CHAPTER 266, Laws of 1973

AN ACT to amend 13.47 (intro.); and to create 13.47 (3) of the statutes, relating to changing the name and certain duties of the committee to visit state properties.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 13.47 (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:

13.47 (title) Legislative state supported programs study and advisory committee. (intro.) There is created a joint legislative state supported programs study and advisory committee to visit state properties, consisting of 5 senators and 6 representatives to the assembly, appointed as are standing committees in the respective houses. The 2 major political parties shall be represented in the membership from each house.

SECTION 2. 13.47 (3) of the statutes is created to read:

13.47 (3) VISITS TO INSTITUTIONS RECEIVING STATE FUNDS. The committee, in groups or individually as assigned by the chairman with the consent of the committee, may visit any institution, program or organization in this state in which the state directly or indirectly has provided financial support. Upon request of the committee,

any such institution, program or organization shall allow the committee to examine its records.
