zoning matters as provided in sub. (2) (a). Such petition shall be filed with the county clerk who shall present it immediately refer it to the county zoning agency. Immediate notice of the petition shall be sent to the county supervisor of any affected district. A reporting of all petitions referred under this paragraph shall be made to the county board at its next succeeding meeting.
