CHAPTER 312, Laws of 1973

AN ACT to authorize the filling of certain lands beneath the waters of the Fox river for construction of a bulkhead.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. All the right, title and interest of the state of Wisconsin in and to the waters of the Fox river east of and adjacent to the west shoreline thereof in the city

of De Pere, county of Brown, from the shoreline to a line drawn between the points described below is hereby granted, and ceded to the respective landowners of the riverbed for the construction of a bulkhead, to wit:

Commencing at the Northeast corner of Lot Seven (7), Block Three (3), of the Schneider Plat, West Side of Fox River, City of De Pere, Brown County, Wisconsin; thence North 26° 16' East a distance of 60.00 feet to the Northerly line of Leonard Street; thence South 64° 00' East a distance of 1158.36 feet along said Northerly line to the point of beginning of this description and designated as point "A"; thence South 36° 23' West a distance of 698.22 feet to a point designated as point "B"; thence North 63° 03' West a distance of 268.75 feet to a point designated as point "C", said point "C" being located on the West shore of the Fox River; thence Northeasterly along the West shore of the Fox River to point "A" the point of beginning which lies North 56° 02' 19" East a distance of 788.19 feet from said point "C".

SECTION 2. The legislature hereby authorizes the filling of that portion of the Fox river the interests to which are conveyed in SECTION 1, and permits the construction of a bulkhead between the points therein described by the respective landowners, in aid of the installation of sewage treatment facilities by the city of De Pere.
