CHAPTER 32, Laws of 1973

AN ACT to appropriate \$11,964 from the general fund for payment of a claim made by the estate of Werner Schmid against the state.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

There is appropriated from the general fund \$11,964 to the estate of Werner Schmid of Merrill, Wisconsin, as reimbursement for cows disposed of at the Schmid farm between April 22, 1970 and August 25, 1970 on the recommendation of the state department of agriculture. Ninety-four of the 134 cows disposed of were nonreactors to tubercular testing, but were disposed of anyway to clean out the herd. Acceptance

of this payment shall operate	as a full	and complete	release to the	state for any claim
on account of said loss.
