CHAPTER 56, Laws of 1973

- AN ACT to ratify the agreement negotiated between the state of Wisconsin and the (security and public safety) Wisconsin state employes union, AFSCME, Council 24, and its appropriate affiliated locals, AFL-CIO, and authorizing an expenditure of funds.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Agreement ratified. The legislature hereby ratifies the tentative agreement negotiated between the state of Wisconsin, department of administration, and the Wisconsin state employes union, AFSCME, Council 24, and its appropriate

affiliated locals, AFL-CIO, covering employes in the security and public safety bargaining unit under the provisions of chapter 111 of the statutes, as approved by the employes of the security and public safety bargaining unit and approved and recommended by the joint committee on employment relations and authorizes the necessary funds from section 20.865 (1) (cm) of the statutes for implementation. Official certified copies of that agreement shall be filed with the secretary of state.

SECTION 2. Effective date. This act shall become effective on July 1, 1973, and shall remain in effect through June 30, 1975.
