## CHAPTER 59, Laws of 1973

- AN ACT to amend 103.70 (1) and 103.71 (2) of the statutes, relating to child labor permits for agricultural work.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 103.70 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

103.70 (1) Except as otherwise provided in sub. (2) and in ss. 103.21 to 103.31, and as may be provided under s. 103.79, a minor under 18 years of age, unless indentured as an apprentice in accordance with s. 106.01, or unless 12 years and over and engaged in agricultural pursuits, shall not be employed or permitted to work at any gainful occupation or employment unless there is first obtained from the department, or from a person designated by the department, a written permit authorizing the employment of the minor within those periods of time stated therein, which shall not exceed the maximum hours prescribed by law.

SECTION 2. 103.71 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

103.71 (2) A permit shall not be issued authorizing the employment of any minor under 14 years of age at any time, except minors under 14 as provided in s. 103.78, minors 12 and over in school lunch programs, minors 12 years and over engaged in agricultural pursuits, boys 12 and over in street trades as provided in ss. 103.21 to 103.31, and boys 12 and over as caddies on golf courses.
