## CHAPTER 65, Laws of 1973

- AN ACT to repeal chapter 246, laws of 1971, section 2; and to amend 111.70 (4) (jm) (intro.) and 1 of the statutes, relating to compulsory arbitration of labor disputes involving law enforcement personnel in cities of the 1st class.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 111.70 (4) (jm) (intro.) and 1 of the statutes are amended to read:

111.70 (4) (jm) (intro.) This paragraph shall apply only to members of a police department employed by cities of the 1st class. If the representative of members of the police department, as determined under par. (j) (d), and representatives of the city reach an impasse on the terms of the agreement, the dispute shall be resolved in the following manner:

1. Either the representative of the members of the police department or the representative of the city may petition the commission for appointment of an arbitrator to determine the terms of the agreement relating to the wages, hours and working conditions of the members of the police department, within the meaning of par. (j).

SECTION 2. Chapter 246, laws of 1971, section 2, is repealed.
