## CHAPTER 70, Laws of 1973

AN ACT to amend 343.30 (1q) of the statutes, relating to revocation of chauffeurs' licenses for drunken driving.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

343.30 (1q) of the statutes is amended to read:

343.30 (1q) A court shall revoke the operating privilege of a person for a period of not less than 90 days nor more than 6 months upon such person's first conviction for violating s. 346.63 (1) (a) or a local ordinance which is in conformity therewith except that the court shall revoke the operating privilege of a person who refuses to take a test under s. 343.305 for a period of not less than one year upon such person's first conviction for violating s. 346.63 (1) (a) or a local ordinance which is in conformity therewith. If a person licensed as a chauffeur is convicted for operation of a motor vehicle while under the inflience of intoxicating liquor and such person was not operating a vehicle as a chauffeur at the time of the offense, his chauffeur's license shall not be revoked under this section.
