## CHAPTER 81, Laws of 1973

AN ACT to amend 252.19 of the statutes, relating to compensation of circuit court reporters.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

252.19 of the statutes is amended to read:

252.19 Additional compensation of reporters. In addition to the compensation payable from the state treasury, each reporter appointed pursuant to s. 252.18 in the 2nd circuit shall be further compensated for his services at the rate of not less than \$75 nor more than \$200 per month, or any higher amount as determined by the county board, payable out of the treasury of the county comprising such circuit, and in any other circuit divided into 2 or more branches shall be further compensated for his services at the rate of \$50 per month, or any higher amount as determined by the county board, payable out of the treasury of the counties embracing such circuit. If there are 2 or more counties in such circuit, each county shall pay such proportion of said sum as its population at the last census bears to the entire population of such

circuit according to such census. The county board of any county comprising all or part of a circuit having only one judge may elect to pay to the reporter appointed pursuant to s. 252.18 for the circuit such additional compensation as it determines. Such payments shall be made upon affidavit of the reporter and the certificate of the judge with whom the service was performed, showing performance, and filed with the county clerk.
