## CHAPTER 1, Laws of 1975

AN ACT to create 108.141 (9) of the statutes, relating to unemployment compensation extended benefit indicator modifications.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

108.141 (9) of the statutes is created to read:

108.141 (9) INDICATOR MODIFICATIONS. (a) A Wisconsin "on" or "off" indicator shall be determined without regard to sub. (1) (d) 1 or (e) 1 for any period that waiver of such provisions is authorized under s. 203 (e) of Title II of P.L. 91-373 and any amendments thereto on the effective date of this act (1975) or thereafter.

(b) A national "on" or "off" indicator under sub. (1) (b) and (c) shall be determined as though the 4.5% figure contained in such paragraphs were changed to 4.0%. for any period that such change is authorized under s. 203 (d) of Title II of P.L. 91-373 and any amendments thereto on the effective date of this act (1975) or thereafter.
