CHAPTER 10, Laws of 1975

AN ACT to amend 990.001 (4) (e) of the statutes, relating to mailings on days in which the U.S. postal service is not in normal operation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

CHAPTER 10 8

990.001 (4) (e) of the statutes is amended to read:

990.001 (4) (e) "Legal holiday" as used in this section means any state-wide statewide legal holiday provided in s. 256.17. When an act is permitted to be done by the use of the postal service, and the last day within the time prescribed by law for performing such act falls on a legal public holiday under federal law, or other holiday designated by the president such that the postal service does not receive registered mail or make regular deliveries on that day, the day shall be considered a legal holiday for purposes of this section.
