CHAPTER 101, Laws of 1975

- AN ACT to amend 7.30 (6) (b) of the statutes, relating to appointments to fill vacancy of chairman position of election inspectors.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

7.30 (6) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

7.30 (6) (b) At the first election following their appointment, the inspectors shall elect one of their number as chairman of the inspectors. The chairman shall hold the position for the remainder of the term. If a vacancy occurs in the chairman position, the inspectors shall elect municipal clerk may appoint one of their number to serve as chairman until the vacancy is removed.
