CHAPTER 103, Laws of 1975

AN ACT to amend 66.057 (2) (d) of the statutes, relating to raising fees for ID cards from \$2 to \$3.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

66.057 (2) (d) of the statutes is amended to read:

66.057 (2) (d) Fees. A fee determined by the attorney general, but not exceeding of \$3, shall be charged each applicant obtaining an identification card. A fee of \$5 shall be charged those applicants obtaining duplicate cards. The issuing officer shall pay the fees received under this section into the treasury of his county or municipality.
