CHAPTER 123, Laws of 1975

AN ACT to repeal and recreate 66.30 (2) of the statutes, relating to intergovernmental cooperation agreements.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

66.30 (2) of the statutes is repealed and recreated to read:

66.30 (2) In addition to the provisions of any other statutes specifically authorizing cooperation between municipalities, unless such statutes specifically exclude action under this section, any municipality may contract with other municipalities, for the receipt or furnishing of services or the joint exercise of any power or duty required or authorized by law. If municipal parties to a contract have varying powers or duties under the law, each may act under the contract to the extent of its lawful powers and duties. This section shall be interpreted liberally in favor of cooperative action between municipalities.
