## CHAPTER 194, Laws of 1975

AN ACT authorizing the sale of certain lands by the department of natural resources.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

The department of natural resources is authorized and directed to sell or exchange the following lands, now deemed superfluous to state purposes, at public or private sale for fair market value:

In the county of Vilas, state of Wisconsin:

(1) The North half of that part of Government Lot Four (4) lying west of County highway "K", in Section 5, Township 41 North, Range 8 East.

(2) The North 10 acres of the Southeast quarter (SE 1/4) of the Northeast quarter (NE 1/4) of Section 6, of Township 41 North, Range 8 East.

(3) The South 10 acres of the Southwest quarter (SW 1/4) of the Southeast quarter (SE 1/4) and the South half of the Southeast quarter (SE 1/4) of the Southeast quarter (SE 1/4), both parcels being in Section 31, Township 42 North, Range 8 East.
