CHAPTER 229, Laws of 1975

AN ACT to amend 346.38 (1) and (2); and to create 346.47 (3) of the statutes, relating to highway access controls.

S35 CHAPTER 229

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 346.38 (1) and (2) of the statutes are amended to read:

- 346.38 (1) WALK. A pedestrian facing a "Walk" signal may proceed across the roadway or other vehicular crossing in the direction of the signal and shall be given the right of way right-of-way by the operators of all vehicles.
- (2) WAIT OR DON'T WALK. No pedestrian shall start to cross the roadway or other vehicular crossing in the direction of a "Wait" or "Don't Walk" signal, but any pedestrian who has partially completed his crossing on the walk signal may proceed to a sidewalk or safety island while the wait signal is showing.

SECTION 2. 346.47 (3) of the statutes is created to read:

346.47 (3) The operator of a vehicle about to cross or enter a highway from a point of access other than another highway is not required to stop in compliance with sub. (1) if a traffic control officer or official traffic control device directs or permits otherwise.
