CHAPTER 233, Laws of 1975

AN ACT to repeal 66.527 (1) (b), (c) and (d); and to renumber and amend 66.527 (1) (a) of the statutes, relating to deleting the limitation on the amount a town may raise for establishing and operating a recreation department and deleting the option to use a referendum to authorize funding.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

CHAPTER 233 838

SECTION 1. 66.527 (1) (a) of the statutes is renumbered 66.527 (1) and amended to read:

66.527 (1) Funds for the establishment, operation and maintenance of a department of recreation may be provided by the governing body of any town or school district after compliance with the provisions of section <u>s.</u> 65.90 or such funds must be appropriated following a favorable referendum conducted at any regular election.

SECTION 2. 66.527 (1) (b), (c) and (d) of the statutes are repealed.
