CHAPTER 245, Laws of 1975

AN ACT to create 176.04 (4) of the statutes, permitting collectors to sell their unique liquor bottles.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

176.04 (4) of the statutes is created to read:

176.04 (4) Persons who collect ceramic commemorative bottles or other uniquely designed decanters which contain intoxicating liquor and which have unbroken federal tax stamps thereon may sell such containers to other such collectors without a liquor license.
