## **CHAPTER 246, Laws of 1975**

AN ACT to create 29.224 of the statutes, relating to the safe transportation of firearms.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

29.224 of the statutes is created to read:

29.224 Safe use and transportation of firearms. (1) No person may possess, place or transport in or on a motor-driven boat while the motor is running any firearm

or bow unless such firearm is unloaded and enclosed within a carrying case and unless such bow is unstrung or enclosed within a carrying case.

- (2) No person may possess, place or transport in or on any aircraft, vehicle or automobile any firearm or bow unless such bow is unstrung or enclosed within a carrying case or such firearm is unloaded and enclosed within a carrying case.
- (3) No person shall load, fire or shoot any firearm or any bow and arrow in, on or from any automobile, aircraft or vehicle, stationary or moving except as provided in s. 29.09 (9).
