## CHAPTER **316**, Laws of 1975

- AN ACT to amend 15.497 (2) of the statutes, relating to designating a member of the council on veterans programs.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

15.497 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

15.497 (2) COUNCIL ON VETERANS PROGRAMS. There is created in the department of veterans affairs a council on veterans programs consisting of one representative each of the state departments of the American Legion, the Disabled American Veterans, the Veterans of Foreign Wars, the Marine Corps League, the United Spanish War Veterans, the Navy Club of the U. S. A., the Veterans of World War II (AMVETS), the Veterans of World War I of the U. S. A., Inc., the Catholic War Veterans of the U. S. A., the Jewish War Veterans of the U. S. A., the Polish Legion of American Veterans, the National Association of Black Veterans, the Army and Navy Union of the United States of America, the National Association of <u>Concerned Veterans</u> and the Military Order of the Purple Heart, one representative of the American Red Cross and one representative of the Wisconsin county veterans service officers, appointed for one-year terms by the organization each represents.
