CHAPTER 334, Laws of 1975

AN ACT to amend 443.01 (6) (i) of the statutes, relating to examinations for registration as an architect or professional engineer.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

443.01 (6) (i) of the statutes is amended to read:

443.01 (6) (i) Written or written and oral examinations will shall be required of every applicant for registration as an architect or a professional engineer except an applicant who meets the requirements of par. (b) 3. Only one form of examination may be required for all applicants. The examination must be reasonably related to the skills likely to be needed by an applicant practicing his profession at the time of examination and seek to determine the applicant's preparedness to exercise such skills. Failure to pass an examination under this section or under any order of the examining board shall not be a bar to registration under par. (b) 3.
