CHAPTER 339, Laws of 1975

AN ACT to create 36.25 (17) of the statutes, relating to a study of the effects and advantages of the utilization of methane and wood alcohol for commercial and domestic use.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

36.25 (17) of the statutes is created to read:

36.25 (17) WOOD ALCOHOL AND METHANE STUDY PROJECT. The board shall direct the completion of a study to determine the feasibility and desirability of the production of methane gas and wood alcohol for commercial and domestic use. The study shall seek to determine the economic and environmental advantages and disadvantages of such production at various scales and over a period of time, as compared to the cost and projected cost of alternate fuel and power systems. The

board shall publish a report of the findings of its study and provide to the 1977 legislature any recommendations for legislative action which it may deem advisable.
