CHAPTER 362, Laws of 1975

AN ACT to amend 201.05 (1) (b) and 422.202 (1) (b) (intro.); and to create 201.04 (21) of the statutes, relating to the issuance of credit unemployment insurance.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 201.04 (21) of the statutes is created to read:

201.04 (21) Credit Unemployment Insurance — Against loss of income of debtors resulting from either labor disputes or involuntary unemployment.

SECTION 2. 201.05 (1) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

201.05 (1) (b) The insurance specified in s. 201.04 (4) and (5); (4), (4a) and (21); (5) and (15); (5), (15) and (18); (15) and (18); or (1), (5), (6), (7), (10), (11), (12), (13), (14), (17) and (18) or any combination thereof may be written in the same policy with or without separate premium charges.

SECTION 3. 422.202 (1) (b) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:

422.202 (1) (b) (intro.) Charges or premiums for credit life insurance, as defined in ss. 201.04 (3c) and 206.63, or credit accident and sickness insurance, as defined in s. 201.04 (4a), or credit unemployment insurance, as defined in s. 201.04 (21), if:
