CHAPTER 385, Laws of 1975

AN ACT to create 342.07 (3) of the statutes, relating to certificates of title for previously junked automobiles not to be operated on the public highway.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

342.07 (3) of the statutes is created to read:

342.07 (3) Subsections (1) and (2) do not apply if the owner applying for certificate of title for a motor vehicle which has previously been junked certifies to the division that the motor vehicle will not be operated on the public highways. In such case, the division shall stamp on the title: "NOT FOR HIGHWAY USE". If at a subsequent time the owner wishes to operate the motor vehicle on the public highways, he shall comply with subs. (1) and (2) at the time of making application for

registration. In any event, any vehicle which is titled under this section shall be treated as a motor vehicle for the purposes of compliance with this chapter and ch. 346.
