CHAPTER 398, Laws of 1975

AN ACT to amend 118.02 of the statutes, relating to a special observation day on the birthdate of Robert M. La Follette, Sr.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

118.02 of the statutes is amended to read:

118.02 Special observance days. On the following days school shall be held, unless the dates fall on a Saturday or Sunday, and the day shall be appropriately observed: February 12; February 22; April 13, American Creed Day; September 28, Frances Willard Day; October 9, Leif Erikson Day; October 12; and November 11. If any such day falls on a Saturday or Sunday, the observance shall be on a school day immediately preceding or following. If school is held on June 14, that day shall be appropriately observed as Robert M. La Follette, Sr. Day.
