CHAPTER 408, Laws of 1975 (Vetoed in Part)

AN ACT to repeal 39.45; and to create 36.25 (16) of the statutes, relating to authorizing the board of regents of the university of Wisconsin system to establish and maintain a school of veterinary medicine and satellite food animal clinical facility and indreasing appropriations.

Vetoed in Part

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 36.25 (16) of the statutes is created to read:

Partial Veto

36.25 (16) SCHOOL OF VETERINARY MEDICINE AND SATELLITE FOOD ANIMAL CLINICAL FACILITY. The board may establish and maintain a school of veterinary medicine at the university of Wisconsin-Madison and a satellite food animal clinical Overruled facility at the university of Wisconsin-River Falls. Existing facilities at those institutions shall be used to the maximum possible extent for auxiliary instructional and research support of the veterinary and satellite food animal clinical programs.

SECTION 2. 39.45 of the statutes is repealed.
