AN ACT to amend 29.60 (1) of the statutes, relating to permitted use of poison bait.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

## **CHAPTER 52**

29.60 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

29.60 (1) It Except as provided by s. 29.29 (4) it shall be unlawful to put-out use baits containing poison of any description in any forests, fields or other places where it might destroy or cause the destruction of wild animals or birds, and the possession of any such poison or poison baits in a hunting or trapping camp or on any person or persons while hunting or trapping shall be prima facie evidence of a violation hereof.
