1975 Senate Bill 118

CHAPTER 84, Laws of 1975

AN ACT to renumber 347.40; and to create 347.40 (2) of the statutes, relating to mirrors required on the front of school busses as a condition of registration and providing a penalty.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 347.40 of the statutes is renumbered 347.40 (1).

SECTION 2. 347.40 (2) of the statutes is created to read:

347.40 (2) No person shall operate on a highway any school bus having a passenger-carrying capacity of 10 or more persons including the operator unless such bus is equipped with at least one mirror which is 7 inches in diameter so located as to enable the operator to see a reflection of the road from the entire front bumper forward to a point where direct observation is possible.
