## CHAPTER 101, Laws of 1977

- AN ACT to amend 84.04 (1) (c) of the statutes, relating to the size of waysides along highways.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 84.04 (1) (c) of the statutes is amended to read:

84.04 (1) (c) "Wayside" means an area of land adjacent or in close proximity to the highway of not to exceed 5 acres, with facilities developed for the convenience, comfort, and enjoyment of the motoring public, these developments to include parking, sanitary, cooking, and picnicking facilities, together with any other facility or improvement which the commission deems desirable or necessary to accommodate travelers and provide convenient and safe access thereto by pedestrians and vehicles. "Wayside" includes rest areas.
