CHAPTER 139, Laws of 1977

AN ACT to amend 227.12 (1) of the statutes, relating to petition for rehearing before an administrative agency (suggested as remedial legislation by the public service commission).

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 227.12 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

227.12 (1) A petition for rehearing shall not be a prerequisite for appeal or review. Any party to a contested case who deems such party aggrieved by a final order may, within 20 days after entry service of the order, file a written petition for rehearing which shall specify in detail the grounds for the relief sought and supporting authorities. An agency may order a rehearing on its own motion within 20 days after service of a final order. This subsection does not apply to s. 17.025 (3) (e).
