CHAPTER 179, Laws of 1977

AN ACT to create 104.045 of the statutes, relating to discounting tips from employer minimum wage obligations and granting rule-making authority.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 104.045 of the statutes is created to read:

104.045 Tipped employes. The department shall by rule determine what amount of tips or similar gratuities may be counted toward fulfillment of the employer's obligation under this chapter.
