- AN ACT to amend 60.29 (35) of the statutes, relating to town power to pay a nurse practitioner.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 60.29 (35) of the statutes is amended to read:

CHAPTER 18

60.29 (35) (title) RESIDENT PHYSICIANS AND NURSE PRACTITIONER. The town board of any town comprised entirely of one or more islands may annually appropriate such sums as the board determines, to pay as a retainer, for the purpose of maintaining a physician <u>or if no physician is available, a nurse practitioner</u> as a resident within the town.
