CHAPTER 232, Laws of 1977

AN ACT to amend 29.224; and to create 29.104 (4) of the statutes, relating to the use of crossbows by physically disabled, resident archers.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 29.104 (4) of the statutes is created to read:

29.104 (4) (a) After proper application and presentation of a current resident archer hunting license duly issued to the applicant, the secretary may grant to any person who is established by medical evidence, verified by a written statement from a licensed physician, to be unable to operate a manually pulled bow because of a permanent physical disability a special permit to hunt with a crossbow meeting the specifications of par. (b).

(b) Crossbows used in hunting under this subsection shall meet all of the following specifications:

1. Shall be fired from the shoulder;

2. Shall deliver at least 42 ft.-lbs. of energy at a distance of 10 feet;

3. Shall have a stock of not less than 30 continuing inches in length;

4. Shall have a working safety; and

5. Shall be used with arrows or bolts of not less than 10 inches in length with a broadhead.

SECTION 2. 29.224 of the statutes is amended to read:

29.224 Safe use and transportation of firearms. (1) No person may possess, place or transport in or on a motor-driven boat while the motor is running any firearm $\overline{\text{or}}$, bow $\underline{\text{or}}$ crossbow unless such firearm is unloaded and enclosed within a carrying case and unless such bow or crossbow is unstrung or enclosed within a carrying case.

(2) No person may possess, place or transport in or on any aircraft, vehicle or automobile any firearm or, bow <u>or crossbow</u> unless such bow <u>or crossbow</u> is unstrung or enclosed within a carrying case or such firearm is unloaded and enclosed within a carrying case.

(3) No person shall <u>may</u> load, fire or shoot any firearm, <u>crossbow</u> or any bow and arrow in, on or from any automobile, aircraft or vehicle, stationary or moving except as provided in s. 29.09 (9).
