## CHAPTER 256, Laws of 1977

Date published: April 24, 1978

AN ACT to amend 17.245 of the statutes, relating to temporary appointments to fill new local elected offices.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 17.245 of the statutes is amended to read:

17.245 New city, village or town office, temporary appointment. Whenever an elective office is created in a city, village or town pursuant to law or ordinance, a temporary appointment may be made by the governing body pending the election of the incumbent for the first full term the office shall not be deemed vacant until it has first been filled by the electorate.
