CHAPTER 287, Laws of 1977

AN ACT to repeal 8.20 (4) (a) to (f); and to renumber and amend 8.20 (4) (intro.) of the statutes, relating to nomination paper signature requirements for independent candidates for partisan office.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 8.20 (4) (intro.) of the statutes is renumbered 8.20 (4) and amended to read:

8.20 (4) The number of required signatures on nomination papers for independent candidates shall be: the same as the number specified in s. 8.15 (6). For independent presidential electors intending to vote for the same candidates for president and vice president, the number of required signatures shall be not less than 2,000 nor more than 4,000 electors.

SECTION 2. 8.20 (4) (a) to (f) of the statutes are repealed.
