CHAPTER 291, Laws of 1977

AN ACT to repeal and recreate 66.054 (8a) (i) and 176.17 (5a) of the statutes, relating to restrictions on volume discounts to retailers from wholesalers of malt beverages and liquors and providing a penalty.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 66.054 (8a) (i) of the statutes is repealed and recreated to read:

66.054 (8a) (i) Prices charged by a wholesaler of fermented malt beverages shall be the same for all retailers making purchases in similar quantities from the wholesaler, regardless of whether the retailer is a class "A" or class "B" licensee. Any discount offered on fermented malt beverages must be delivered to the retailer in a single transaction and single delivery, and on a single invoice.

SECTION 2. 176.17 (5a) of the statutes is repealed and recreated to read:

176.17 (5a) Prices charged by a wholesaler of intoxicating liquors shall be the same for all retailers making purchases in similar quantities from the wholesaler, regardless of whether the retailer is a "Class A" or "Class B" licensee. Any discount offered on intoxicating liquors must be delivered to the retailer in a single transaction and single delivery, and on a single invoice.
