CHAPTER 295, Laws of 1977

AN ACT to amend 943.13 (1) (a) and (b); and to create 943.13 (1) (d) of the statutes, relating to criminal trespass to land by use of a vehicle and providing a penalty.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 943.13 (1) (a) and (b) of the statutes are amended to read:

943.13 (1) (a) Enters any enclosed or cultivated land of another with intent to catch or kill any birds, animals, or fish on such the land or gather any products of the soil without the express or implied consent of the owner or occupant to engage in any of those activities; or.

(b) Enters or remains on any land of another after having been notified by the owner or occupant not to enter or remain on said <u>the</u> premises; or.

SECTION 2. 943.13 (1) (d) of the statutes is created to read:

943.13 (1) (d) Enters any enclosed or cultivated land of another with a vehicle of any kind without the express or implied consent of the owner or occupant.
