## CHAPTER 3, Laws of 1977

AN ACT to amend 13.80; and to repeal and recreate 16.835 of the statutes, relating to space assignments in the capitol.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 13.80 of the statutes is amended to read:

13.80 Legislative organization, joint committee on. (1) The joint committee on legislative organization created by the joint rules of the legislature, hereafter referred to as the joint committee on legislative organization, is constituted a permanent joint legislative committee with such powers and authority as are provided by law.

(3) The joint committee <u>on legislative organization</u> shall be the policy-making board for and in general supervise the operation of all staff services of the legislature.

(4) The joint committee on legislative organization shall reserve such space as is necessary in the capitol for the use of the legislature.

SECTION 2. 16.835 of the statutes is repealed and recreated to read:

16.835 Offices in capitol. The executive office of the governor shall be located in the capitol. The attorney general, lieutenant governor, supreme court, state treasurer and secretary of state shall each keep a room in the capitol. From the remaining capitol space not reserved for the use of the legislature, the department may assign additional rooms to be used by the attorney general, state treasurer and secretary of state.
