CHAPTER 321, Laws of 1977

AN ACT to amend 176.05 (24) (b) of the statutes, relating to permitting consumption of intoxicating liquor or fermented malt beverages in a building owned by a municipality.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 176.05 (24) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

176.05 (24) (b) This subsection shall not apply to any municipality, any regularly established athletic field or stadium, <u>any building owned by a municipality or county</u>, any school building, any church, premises in any state fair park, or any club as defined in s. 176.01 (8).
