1977 Assembly Bill 903

CHAPTER 329, Laws of 1977

AN ACT to create 448.065 of the statutes, relating to authorizing the medical examining board to grant a permanent license to practice medicine and surgery to certain professors.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 448.065 of the statutes is created to read:

448.065 Permanent license for certain professors. A person who possesses a temporary license under s. 448.04 (1) (b) 2 and who has practiced under such license for 4 or more years may apply for a license to practice medicine and surgery under s. 448.04 (1) (a). If three-fourths of the board find that the applicant is qualified, notwithstanding s. 448.05 (1) (b) and (c) and (2), the board may grant the license. The board may limit the license and, notwithstanding s. 448.02 (3) (a), may continue such limits indefinitely or may remove the limits when it is satisfied that the reasons for the limits no longer exist.
