CHAPTER 334, Laws of 1977

AN ACT to amend 753.10 (3) of the statutes, relating to pay of officers of certain circuit courts.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 753.10 (3) of the statutes, as affected by chapter 187, laws of 1977, is amended to read:

753.10 (3) Except when <u>Unless</u> otherwise directed by the presiding judge, no officer, other than the clerk, shall be paid for attending court or the judge when if the court is not engaged in the trial of jury cases. Every officer attending court upon the order of the presiding judge shall have the same powers and authority as the sheriff,

and shall be paid out of the county treasury, upon the certificate of such the judge, compensation equal to that fixed by the county board for jurors of the respective county where such court is held; but shall. No such officer may be paid for no any day when the court is not in session unless specially ordered by the presiding judge.

SECTION 2. Effective date. This act shall take effect on August 1, 1978.
