## CHAPTER 396, Laws of 1977

AN ACT to amend 15.105 (5) of the statutes, relating to membership of the state capitol and executive residence board.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 15.105 (5) of the statutes is amended to read:

15.105 (5) STATE CAPITOL AND EXECUTIVE RESIDENCE BOARD. There is created a state capitol and executive residence board which is attached to the department of administration under s. 15.03. The board shall consist of the secretary of administration or his the secretary's designee, the director of the historical society, the head of the engineering function or his <u>or her</u> designee, 3 members of the senate and 3 members of the assembly appointed as are members of standing committees and 67 citizen members, of whom at least 2 shall be architects licensed in this state, one shall be a landscape architect and 3 shall hold membership in the American institute of be interior designers, appointed for staggered 6-year terms.
