CHAPTER 13, Laws of 1979

AN ACT to amend 158.10 (5) and 158.12 (5) of the statutes, relating to the number of barber apprentices that may be employed in a barber shop and the number of barber apprentices that may be supervised by a barber shop manager.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 158,10 (5) of the statutes is amended to read:

158.10 (5) No apprentice or journeyman barber shall may practice barbering except under the immediate personal supervision and direction of a licensed shop manager and eannot nor may be the owner, manager, director or lessee of a barber shop or have any interest therein in a barber shop other than as an employe. Not more than 3 apprentices shall be employed at any barber shop. Each apprentice shall be assigned to a full-time licensed shop manager, but, no more than one apprentice 3 apprentices shall be assigned to each full-time licensed shop manager.

SECTION 2. 158.12 (5) of the statutes is amended to read:

158.12 (5) No shop manager shall employe or authorize employment of more than 3 apprentices in any one barber shop nor <u>may</u> supervise more than one apprentice <u>3</u> apprentices.
