CHAPTER 146, Laws of 1979

AN ACT to amend 341.265 of the statutes, relating to the use of antique motor vehicles.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 341.265 of the statutes is amended to read:

341.265 Antique motor vehicles; registration, plates, use. Any person who is a resident of this state and the owner (and any subsequent transferee) of a motor vehicle which is more than 40 years old at the time of making application for registration of the vehicle may upon application register the same as an antique vehicle upon payment of a fee of \$5, and be furnished license plates of a distinctive design, in lieu of the usual license plates, which shall show in addition to the identification number that the vehicle is an antique. The registration shall be valid while the vehicle is owned by the applicant without the payment of any additional fee. The vehicle shall only be used for special occasions such as display and parade purposes or for necessary testing, maintenance and storage purposes. Unless inconsistent with this section, the provisions applicable to other motor vehicles shall apply to antique motor vehicles.
