## CHAPTER 152, Laws of 1979

AN ACT to amend 346.37 (1) (c) 3 of the statutes, relating to right and left turn on red signals and providing a penalty.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 346.37 (1) (c) 3 of the statutes is amended to read:

346.37 (1) (c) 3. Vehicular traffic facing a red signal at an intersection may, after stopping as required under subd. 1, cautiously enter the intersection to make a right turn into the nearest lawfully available lane for traffic moving to the right or to turn left from a one-way roadway onto highway into the nearest lawfully available lane of a one-way roadway highway on which vehicular traffic travels to the left, unless. No turn may be made on a red signal if lanes of moving traffic are crossed or if a sign at the intersection prohibits such a turn, but. In making a turn on a red signal vehicular traffic shall yield the right-of-way to pedestrians lawfully within a crosswalk and to other traffic lawfully using the intersection.
