CHAPTER 172, Laws of 1979

AN ACT to amend 163.51 (19); and to create 163.51 (22) (g) of the statutes, relating to bingo procedures and card printing. (This is remedial legislation suggested by the department of regulation and licensing.)

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 163.51 (19) of the statutes is amended to read:

163.51 (19) (title) BINGO CARDS; PRINTING. Bingo cards shall be sold or rented without disclosing the face of the card to either the purchaser or seller. Bingo cards shall be printed only on one side. No player shall be given the opportunity to select any particular card on the basis of the numbers appearing thereon.

SECTION 2. 163.51 (22) (g) of the statutes is created to read:

163.51 (22) (g) Immediately following the calling of each number in a bingo game, the caller shall turn that portion of the object which shows the number and letter to the players.
