## CHAPTER 187, Laws of 1979

AN ACT to amend 29.01 (8) of the statutes, relating to the definition of resident for the purposes of fish and game laws.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 29.01 (8) of the statutes is amended to read:

29.01 (8) RESIDENT. "Resident" means any a person who has maintained a his or her place of permanent abode in this state for a period of 30 days immediately preceding an his or her application for license. Domiciliary intent is required to establish that a person is maintaining his or her place of permanent abode in this state. Mere ownership of property is not sufficient to establish domiciliary intent. Evidence of domiciliary intent includes, without limitation, the location where the person votes, pays personal income taxes or obtains a driver's license.
