CHAPTER 21, Laws of 1979

AN ACT to amend 67.04 (1) (0); and to repeal and recreate 59.07 (33) (a) and (b) of the statutes, relating to county authority to appropriate money for public museums in the county, to own and operate a public museum and to issue certain bonds.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 59.07 (33) (a) and (b) of the statutes are repealed and recreated to read:

59.07 (33) (a) Appropriate money for the establishment, expansion, operation and maintenance of public museums in the county, including, but not limited to, any public museum owned by a city.

(b) Acquire, establish, expand, own, operate and maintain a public museum in the county and appropriate money for such purposes.

SECTION 2. 67.04 (1) (o) of the statutes is amended to read:
