CHAPTER 224, Laws of 1979

AN ACT to appropriate \$7,581.74 from the general fund for payment of a claim made by John R. Moses against the state.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Claim against the state. There is appropriated \$7,581.74 from the general fund to John R. Moses, Madison, Wisconsin, as reimbursement for legal expenses incurred in contesting his removal from the position of secretary of veterans affairs on May 20, 1977, which was held to be unlawful by the supreme court. Acceptance of this payment operates as a full and complete release to the state for any claim arising as a result of such removal and all attorney fees, costs and disbursements incurred in connection with contesting this action.
